Event description

Supported by the Barcelona Convention and MedWaves, the United Nations Environment Programme/Mediterranean Action Plan (UNEP/MAP) Regional Activity Centre for Sustainable Consumption and Production, the Switchers Community fosters a vibrant network of entrepreneurs dedicated to implementing sustainable practices. This event will showcase key impacts of the Switchers Support Programme, emphasizing how sustainable business services contribute to addressing urgent environmental and social issues while promoting circular economies in the Mediterranean.

Addressing the ecological and social challenges faced by the Arab region and beyond demands the growth of sustainable and circular micro-, small-, and medium-sized enterprises (MSMEs). To effectively highlight the contributions of these sustainable MSMEs in tackling critical ecological and social issues, it is essential for them to assess their impacts. The event will provide a platform for knowledge exchange and networking, and will delve into a topic of interest to the community: how to assess the environmental and social impact of sustainable MSMEs.







Sustainable MSMEs must distinguish themselves from traditional competitors by clearly demonstrating their ecological and social value to a variety of stakeholders, including potential customers, impact investors, and public authorities. To facilitate this, a range of methodologies and tools are available to support companies in their efforts. At the upcoming event, attendees will have the opportunity to explore different institutional perspectives, tools, and experiences related to assessing the environmental and social impact of businesses.

This event is co-organized by MedWaves, the UNEP/MAP Regional Activity Centre for Sustainable Consumption and Production, the Interreg NEXT MED Programme, and the Partnership for Research and Innovation in the Mediterranean Area (PRIMA).

Event objectives

The primary goals of this event include the following:

- Key goal 1: Showcase the diverse and innovative sustainable business models within the Switchers Community, demonstrating their impact on addressing ecological and social challenges in the Mediterranean region.
- **Key goal 2:** Analyse the importance of the triple impact assessment for MSMEs.
- **Key goal 3:** Present methodologies and tools for evaluating the environmental, social and economic impacts of MSMEs.
- Key goal 4: Provide a platform for networking and sharing best practices among MSMEs and experts, strengthening the community's capacity to address ecological and social challenges.

- Topic 1: The importance of assessing triple impacts for MSMEs.
- **Topic 2:** Understanding the institutional and business perspectives on sustainable MSMEs impact assessment.
