EVENT DESCRIPTION

The Switchers Talks is an event organised by the Switchers Community, the biggest community of sustainable business models in the Mediterranean Region. Supported by the Barcelona Convention and MedWaves, the UNEP/MAP Regional Activity Centre for SCP, the Switchers Community fosters a vibrant network of entrepreneurs dedicated to implementing sustainable practices. This event will showcase key impacts of the Switchers Support Programme, emphasizing how sustainable business services contribute to addressing urgent environmental and social issues while promoting circular economies in the Mediterranean.

Addressing the ecological and social challenges facing the Arab world and beyond demands the growth of sustainable and circular micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs). To effectively highlight the contributions of these sustainable MSMEs in tackling critical ecological and social issues, it is essential for them to assess their impacts.

The event will also provide a platform for knowledge exchange and networking, and in 2024 will delve into a topic of interest of the community: how to assess environmental and social impact of sustainable MSMEs.

Sustainable MSMEs must distinguish themselves from traditional competitors by clearly demonstrating their ecological and social value to a variety of stakeholders, including potential customers, impact investors, and public authorities. opportunity to explore different institutional perspectives, tools, and experiences related to assessing the environmental and social impacts of businesses.
